- Georgia Legislators
 - Tool needed to help with career advising interest <u>and</u> aptitude
- Prior to FY 15 YouScience piloting began in 10 school districts
- **FY 16** Piloting continued
- Results from the piloting looked promising
- <u>FY 17</u> GaDOE & TCSG shared cost of YouScience for state-wide implementation (10th grade encouraged) – high school version (later called Summit)
- Educators immediately wanted to provide YouScience earlier to students.
- FY 19 YouScience Snapshot introduced (7th & 8th graders)
- **FY 20** YouScience Snippet introduced (6th grade interest only)




YouScience: the Georgia Perspective

Results help students consider jobs they have never considered before.





YouScience in GA

The chart below shows the year that the student initially completed the YouScience aptitude assessment. Students continue to have 10-year access to YouScience as a resource..










Completed compared to Enrollment

High School You Science Profile Completions, AY 2020





