## State of Georgia Health Care Workforce

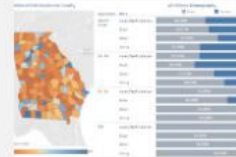

This information is important in determining trends in workforce patterns (i.e. demographics, specialty, and geographical location) and assessing the healthcare workforce needs of Georgia's population.

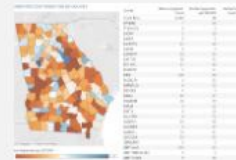

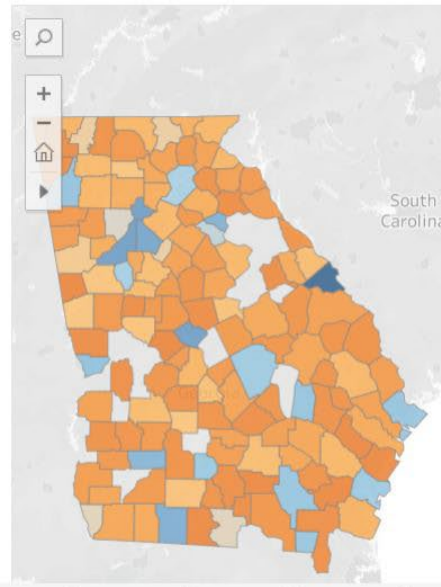

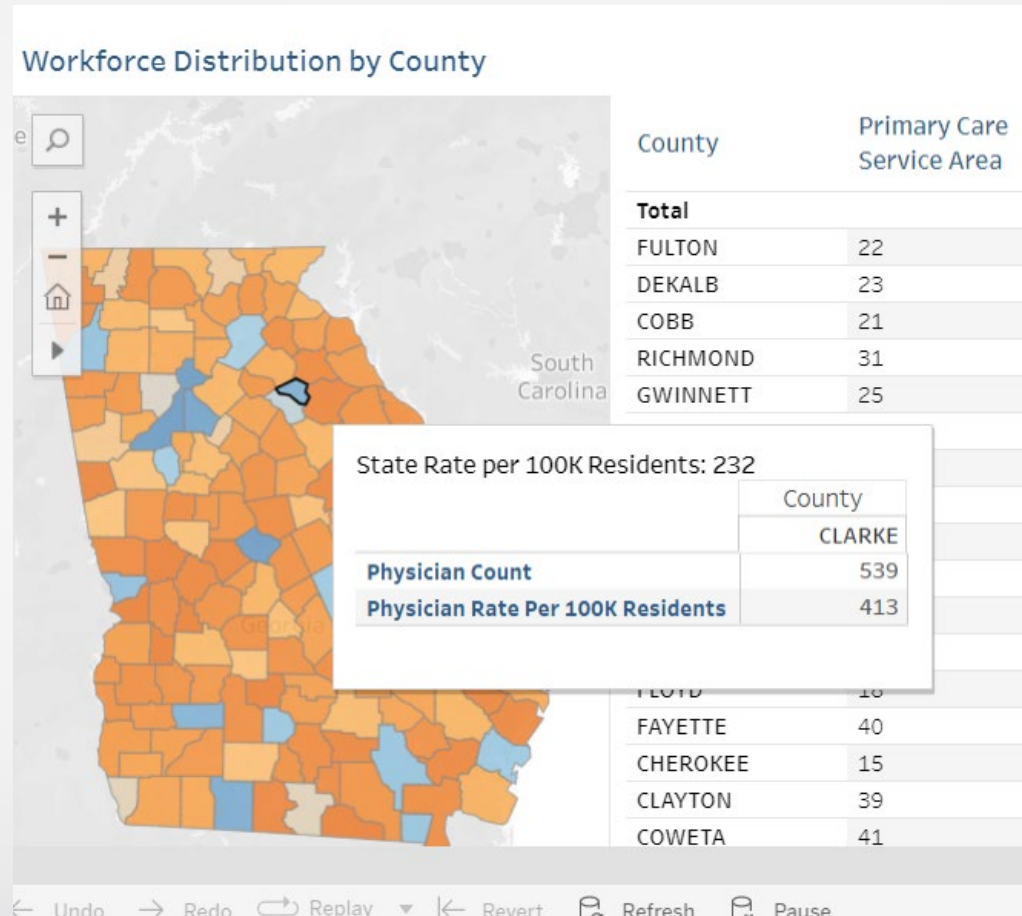


